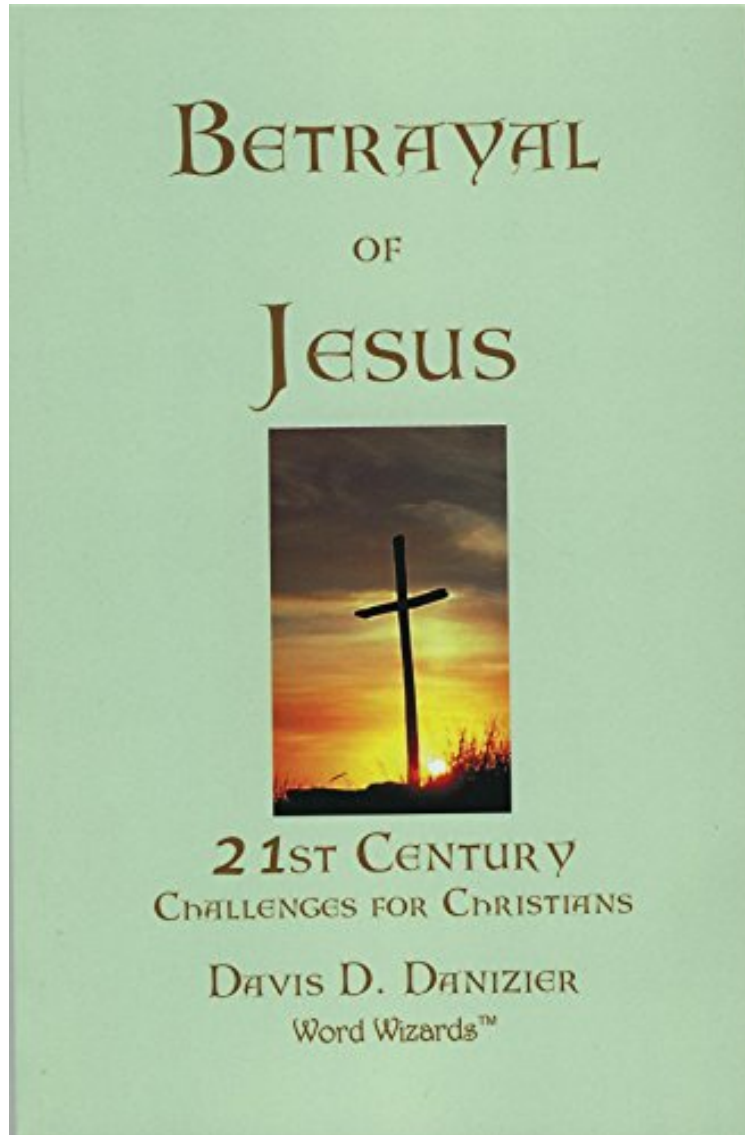

His ideas have a lot of merit,

but there's also textual evidence that Jesus' morality was equally bankrupt as Paul's, and textual evidence that Paul had access to words and ideas of Jesus that were not recorded in the Gospels. Finally, he has to deal with, but does not, the fact that most of the Gospels were written down after Paul wrote many of his letters, confounding any superficial attempt to delineate between the two.
