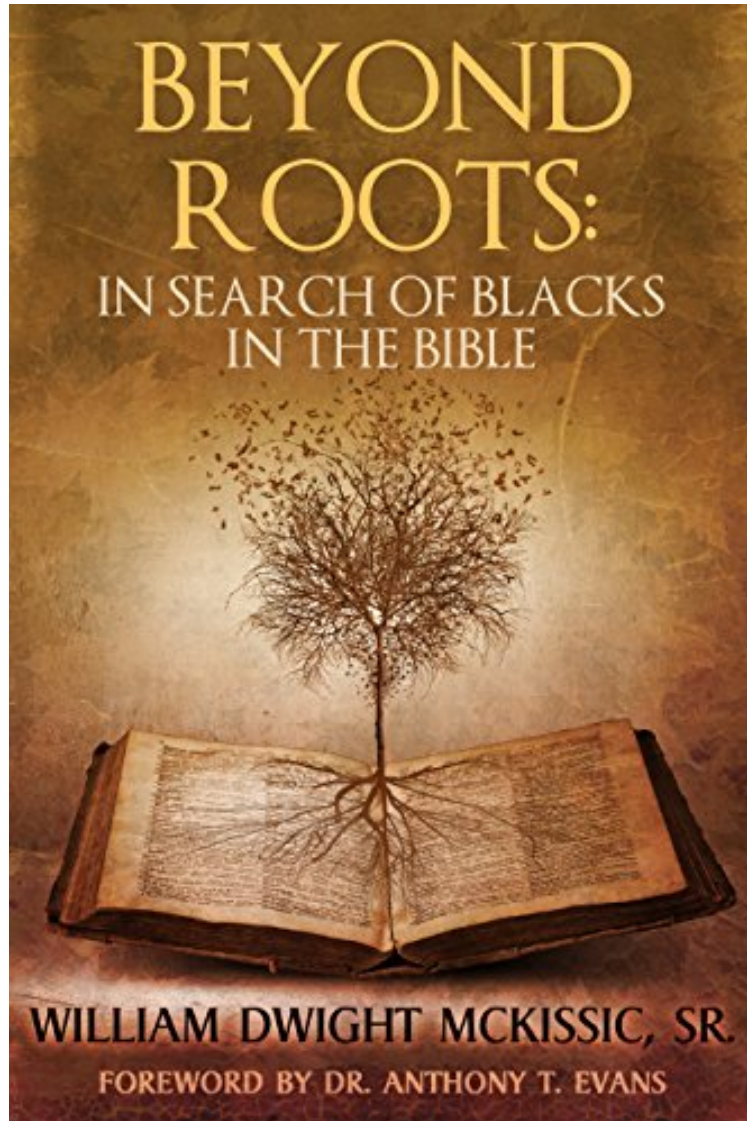

I've given copies of this book especially to African-American young men who feel that trusting Christ as Savior is selling out and turning your back on your race. This book helps young people to see that much of what they hear are cultural biases and not from the Bible. With the aid of Rev. McKissic, African Americans can discover the part that Africa did play in biblical times and get a great historical perspective. You can love Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior and not have to give in to Uncle Tom theology at the same time.
