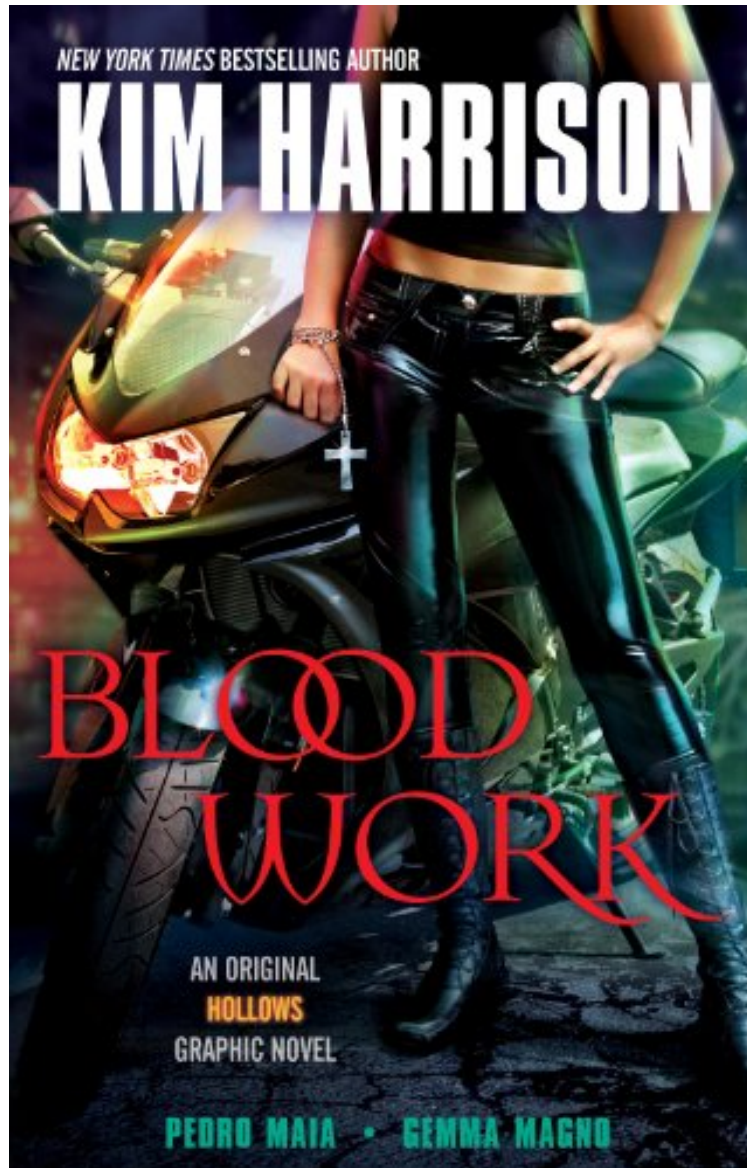

I got the book yesterday, started to read and didn't stop until I absorbed every last page of WWBC. Up front: I LIKED this book. There are entertaining characters, we get to meet Rachel's family, characters from her past, of course some hilarious AI-action thrown in for good measure and unfortunately only a hint of Trent, Quen Ceri (well, at least they got to shine in the last book). Overall an enjoyable ride that will - yet again - leave you begging for the next installment in the series. However I did not LOVE this book, not the way I loved the previous installments, for there are definitely some major weaknesses in this one: First of all, the way that the story about Kist's murder was resolved seemed to be uninspired. Like the author had no idea how to make an interesting plot twist out of it but nevertheless seemed to be hell-bent on finally finishing this story line. Introducing Pierce (from the short story in anthology "Holidays are Hell") and acting as if we should have known him for years might put of readers that haven't read the short story (you might want to before starting WWBC). A definite solution to the Rachel-Ivy relationship would be a fresh breeze in the series...I am kind of getting bored of this yes-no-maybe they have going on. And I thought they actually put an end to every relationship other than their great friendship in the last book. Marshall...well...Marshall. I do hope Rachel finally settles on someone (preferably not Marshal). It is sad to see a woman who was so careful with her affections in the first couple of books to now just throw it at whoever shows up on her radar. Nevermind that she has a relationship interest in as many as 3 (three!) people in this book - when it used to take three books for her to start a relationship (with Kisten). Makes her look flighty. And if you hoped for some Ever-After - won't find it here. Just about one single sentence that describes her weekly date with Al. Last but not least: Rachel is a tough as nails heroine - at least she used to be. Now she is whining about being called black witch by the community and being shunned by her fellow witches. Stop whining, do something. Rachel of Book 1-6 would roll up her sleeves and get to work, not roll up in corner hoping it will all go away. Still, just to meet my favorite characters again I give this book 4,5 stars. Basically because even a not so good book by Kim Harrison is still way better than a lot of other books out there. And here's still hoping that Rachel will mature and find back to her old form in book 8.
