Captain America's black partner, has gone rogue. And who is impersonating Captain America and stalking the Falcon, and why? I bought the book out of blind faith in Mr. Priest's writing, after he blew my mind with his run on Marvel's Black Panther. The book delivers, serving a good helping of political controversy and a spy story featuring an "Anti-Cap" and showing off Captain America's and the Falcon's strength as a team and brains above brawn. All that, almost in spite of Bart Sears' beautiful and hormone-driven art-style. His art makes for a cartoony look, but he can handle the darkness of the themes and his style is still perfectly suited for a superhero comic book. Some layouts are a bit confusing, but I'd rather appreciate the diversity than chastise some awkward results. Colours and inking are a bit uneven though, but I'll chalk that up to an inexperienced colorist and two different inkers. Priest's almost cut-up approach to comic storytelling in Black Panther is downplayed here, in favour of two different timelines reaching a crossing point and then diverging (or rather, proceeding in parallel) again before finally reconnecting towards the end. A good book, that suffers somewhat from a writer with an agenda and an unexpected tendency to be a bit didactic and from some puzzling art.
