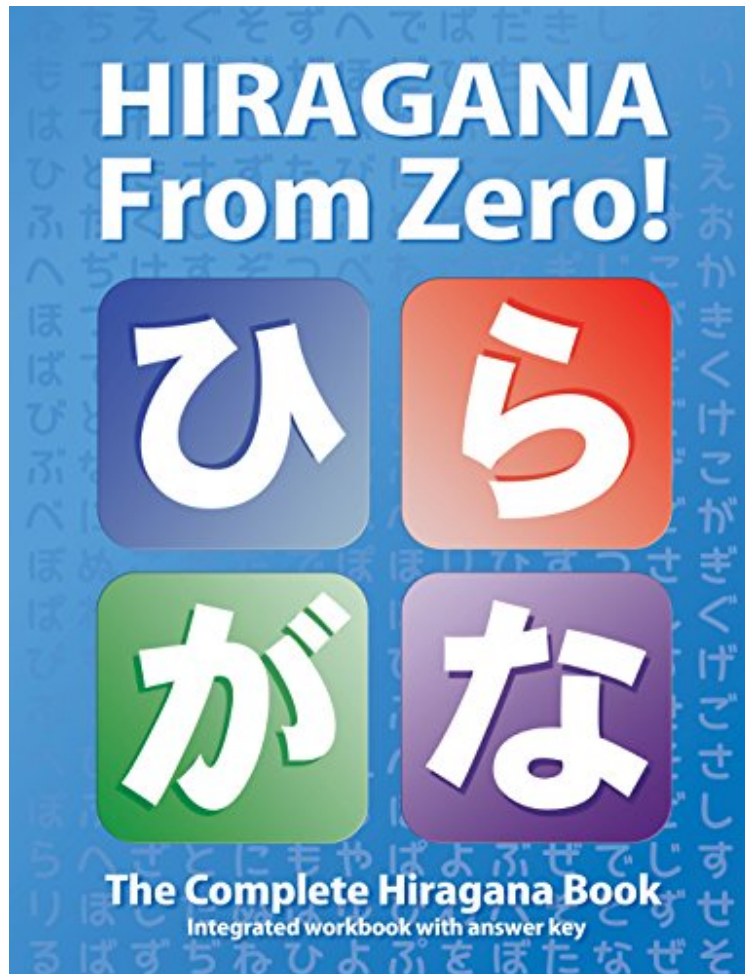

learning to not only read, but also properly write Hiragana. The book consists of several lessons covering about five Hiragana each, in the course of which you will learn to properly draw the characters (emphasis on correct stroke order and possible writing styles), put them into example words and write words out of the characters you know up to that point. I might add that in order to make it easier to memorize the characters, I decided to learn them not in the way provided (order: a, i, u, e, o / ka, sa, ta, na, ha, ma, ya, ra, wa) but rather in an alphabetical order (a, e, i, o, u / ha, ka, ma, na, ra, sa, ta, wa, ya). Even though this leads to a little extra confusion (you do the later lessons first), I could more easily sort the characters in my mind this way. I would recommend the book if you are looking to learn to write Hiragana and enjoy doing so with the help of a practice book, rather than using (free) internet sources and a sheet of paper. If you are planning to buy "Japanese From Zero! 1", do not buy this book, because it is fully included in "Japanese From Zero! 1".

Das Buch besteht aus mehreren Lektionen welche sich jeweils mit etwa fünf Hiragana befassen, und in deren Verlauf man lernt, die Buchstaben ordentlich zu zeichnen (mit dem Schwerpunkt auf der korrekten Strichfolge und den verschiedenen Schreibstilen), sie in Beispielswörtern zu verwenden sowie Worte aus den Zeichen zu schreiben, die man bis dahin schon kennt. Dazu möchte ich noch bemerken, dass ich, um mir die Zeichen leichter merken zu können, mich entschieden habe diese nicht in der vorgegebenen Reihenfolge zu lernen (a, i, u, e, o / ka, sa, ta, na, ha, ma, ya, ra, wa), sondern vielmehr in einer alphabetischen Anordnung (a, e, i, o, u / ha, ka, ma, na, ra, sa, ta, wa, ya). Obwohl dadurch ein bisschen Verwirrung entsteht (man bearbeitet die späteren Lektionen zuerst), konnte ich die Zeichen dadurch leichter in meinem Kopf ordnen. Ich würde das Buch jedem empfehlen, der Hiragana gerne mithilfe eines Übungsbuchs schreiben lernen möchte, anstatt (kostenlose) Internetdienste und ein Blatt Papier zu verwenden. Sollten Sie planen, sich "Japanese From Zero! 1" zu kaufen, verzichten Sie am besten auf dieses Buch, da es vollständig in "Japanese From Zero! 1" enthalten ist.
