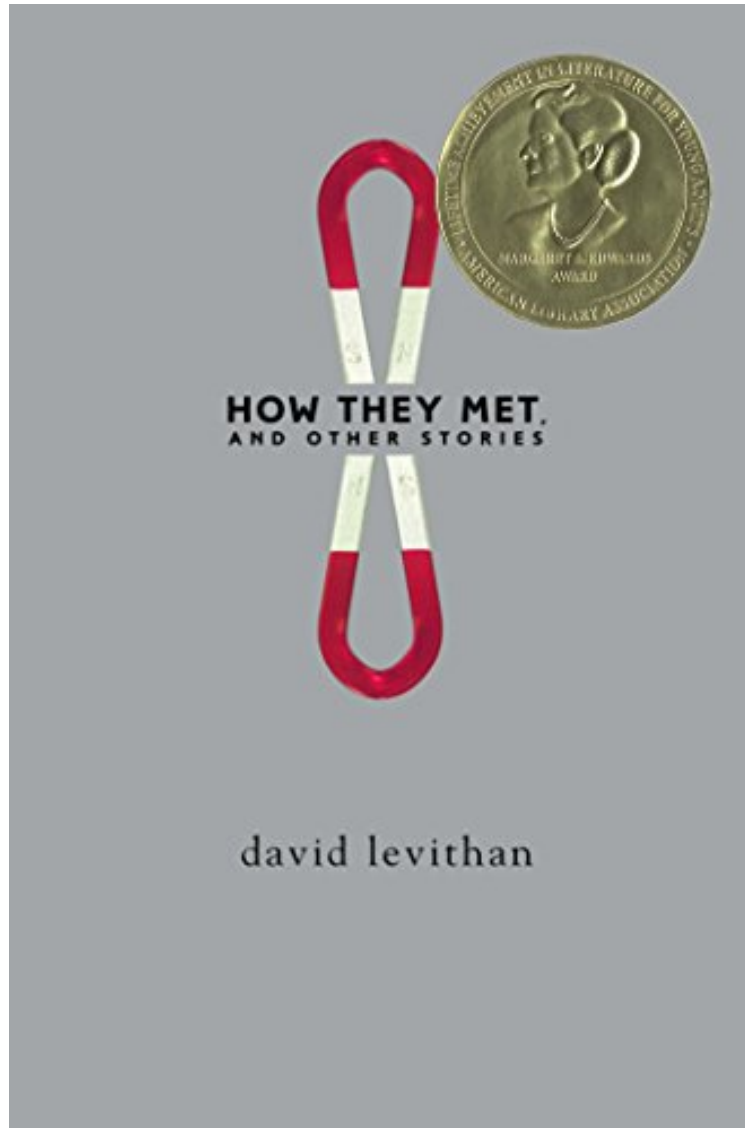

von David Levithan ist eine Kurzgeschichtensammlung, deren einzelne Geschichten grtenteils bereits in anderen Sammelbnden erschienen sind. Levithan zeichnet sich vor allem dadurch aus, dass er es versteht, in einzelne Stze so viel Poesie zu legen, so dass man nie das Gefhl hat, dass es platt wirkt. Dabei rangieren die Gesichten von ersten Begegnungen mit dem/der Richtigen ber vergangene Beziehungen und deren (teilweise nicht abgeschlossene) Aufarbeitung oder einfach nur die Darstellung von Leben. Das mag sich vielleicht nach "alles und nichts" anhren, aber Levithan, der schon mit "Nick and Norah's Infinite Playlist" (zusammen mit Rachel Cohn) ein brillantes Buch vorgelegt hat, zeigt das Leben von Teenagern in so vielen (romantisch/tragischen) Facetten, dass man jedem Charakter seine Wnsche und Probleme glaubt.
