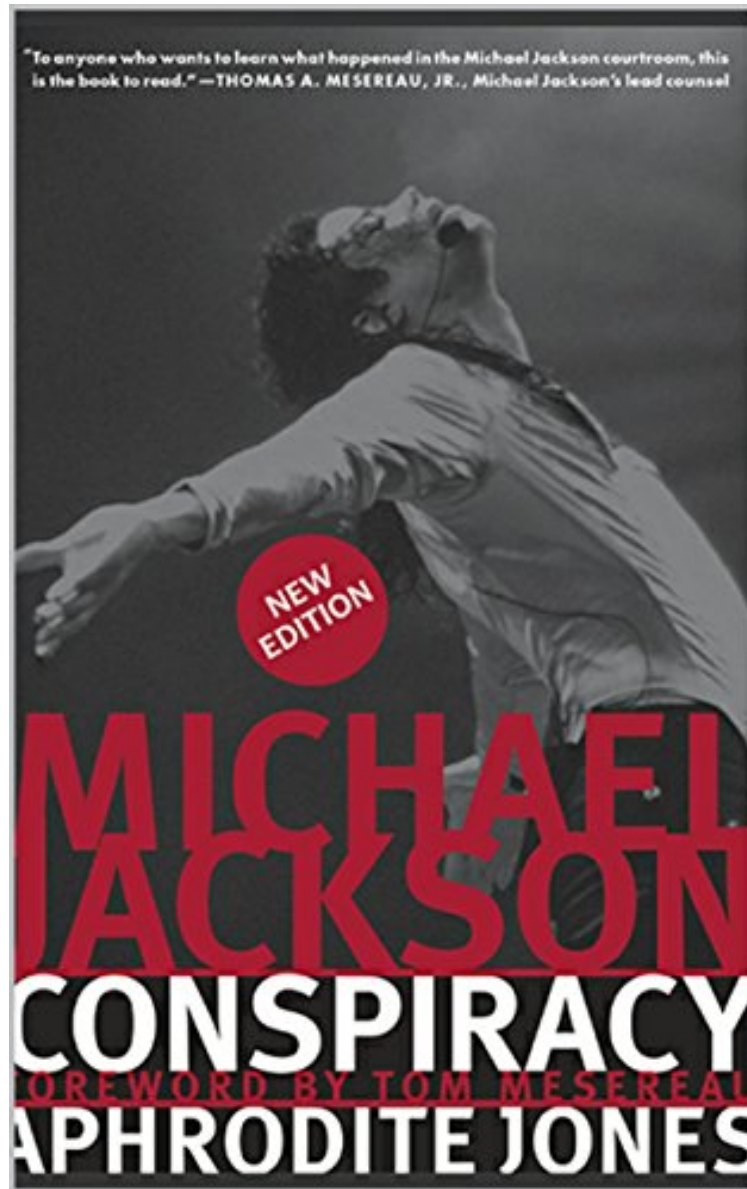

(Golden Rule) Von Leser Aphrodite Jones commented the molestation trial Michael Jackson had to face in 2005. In 2007 she wrote a book about the trial because she knew that the public was misled by the media about what really happened inside the courtroom. Often even the journalists were surprised about what they heard. They certainly hadn't expected this when they prejudged Michael Jackson before the trial had started. She describes the footage that was never used for Martin Bashir's documentary in order to draw a certain picture about living on Neverland. She describes the procedure of the DA who needed more law enforcement to raid Michael Jackson's ranch than was ever used in the history of the USA to catch a serial killer. They could not find any substantial proof that Michael Jackson ever molested the child. She describes that even the witnesses for the prosecution had to admit they had trouble with the boy's family and that money has often been an issue. Finally former child star Macaulay Culkin testified not only that he has never been molested by Michael Jackson as the prosecutors claimed but also that they never even interviewed him. In 2012 she published this updated version. She describes the media's continuing ignorance regarding the 2005 trial and her attempts to make unseen materials public. Originally Aphrodite Jones wanted to delve into the claims that Michael's death was a conspiracy but after having observed the Conrad Murray trial she was convinced that there was nobody behind him. Finally she reviewed some medical records by Dr. Arnold Klein but she decided not to use that information- because she believes in the Golden Rule. So the story ends with a cliffhanger. A civil law suit against AEG is scheduled for April 2013. Maybe the medical records will be mentioned during that trial. Aphrodite Jones also interviewed a physician who has treated Michael Jackson. It can be watched on her website. Many aspects are only shortly mentioned and dropped again. This is a bit confusing for the reader but maybe one book is not enough to describe what happened. I hope she will continue her efforts regarding the trial of 2005. EDIT 05/09/2013 In this book Aphrodite Jones describes the testimony of Wade Robson who even under cross examination by the prosecution denied a sexual abuse by Michael Jackson.
