Yes when you read any of her stories, you are left with a belief that everything will work out and miracles do happen. Miss Me Not is about a girl - Madison- "playing" with some ideas on suicide, and not just playing but pretty

much making up a plan to do that with her best friend. This plan is ruined when a fellow student commits his own suicide. This unfortunate event sets a number of fortunate events in motion which irrevocably change the life and Madison's general point of view on life and death. We learn about Madison's past and what has led to her isolation at the age of 13. The story is not fast-paced but gives a deep insight into Madison's inner turmoil, which I am usually not fond of, but in this story it's an absolute must. The characters are well developed and their actions sound plausible though their perfection is sometimes unbelievable, which again is an OK thing. I really liked Madison and Dean (here I should say Tiffany's main male characters are just perfection per se). It was interesting to watch how their relationship developed. The only thing that felt rushed was Madison's failed relationship to her father. The reasons of his absence were simply sketched, mentioned in a sentence or two. I personally would like to hear the whole story behind. The problem of suicide especially among teenagers is always a very difficult topic to handle but Tiffany King mastered her way and showed with this simple story that it doesn't matter what happens you always matter and suicide is not a way out. I definitely recommend this book! It's amazing!
