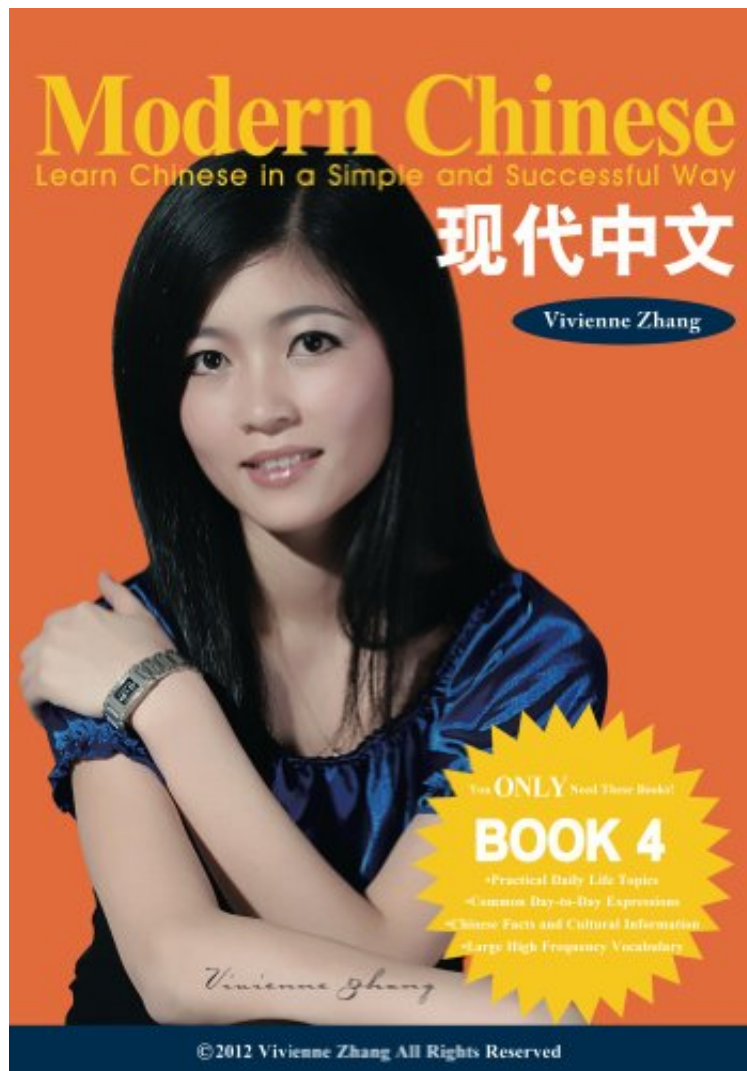

I stuck to it while the flight and also while practicing my vocabulary in the evening and was very positively surprised. It keeps its promise and is smart, simple and very good. The four books are methodically and didactically well organized and follow an intelligent path to build up the relevant basics in Chinese step by step. Man man lai. The foundations of pinyin and Chinese grammar are built up step by step with well chosen examples and a smart approach to digest the most important issues of each chapter. Intelligent holistic path to basic Chinese. Especially for structured and strategic learners who follow a Pareto approach (20/80) to gather quick results the four books are the right choice. You will find yourself in a natural flow through the chapters to repeat your status quo and to build up your portfolio of Chinese vocabulary and grammar in effective manner. No waste and unnecessary parts who would bore you out. Book 1 is focused on pronunciation, pinyin basics and essential grammar topics like time, numbers, adjectives and measuring. These 4 books, however, are the perfect basis to not only learn basic Chinese but also improve your Chinese gradually and constantly to an advanced level. I had a lot of fun working with these books and the gradual increase in complexity regarding vocabulary and grammar was just right for me - steady and challenging but not too steep. It absolutely matches the needs of Western learners. Book 4 is similar to book 3 but gives additional precious insights into Chinese culture and habits. In summary, I can only say value for money.
