She vows that if the nerve recovers, she will write a book about it and fortunately, the nerve does recover. She starts the book with an explanation of various brain hormones involved and how the vaginal nerve is directly connected to the dopaminergic system in the brain and how proper stimulation of this system leads to happiness, but also to an unlocking of creative powers.
