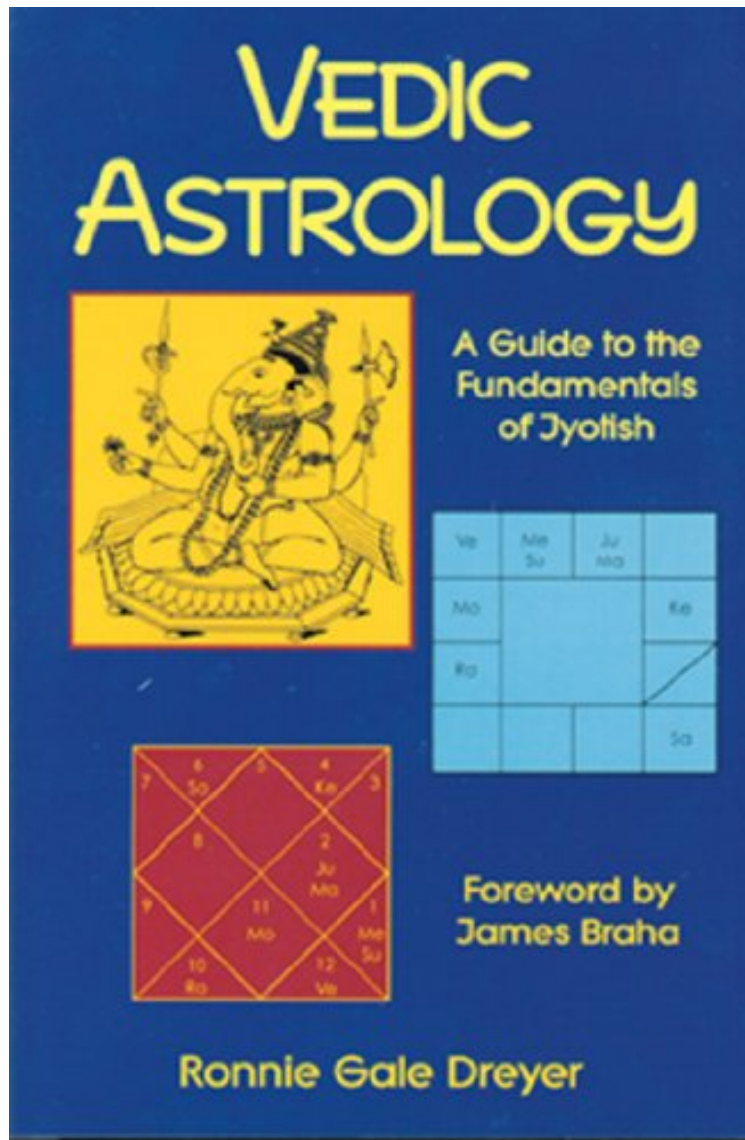

The section about the divisionals is bad..why tell you how to construct a navamsa or hora chart if she doesn't tell you how to use it during interpretation? It's an okay introductory text..but I strictly mean "just okay". Light on Life by Hart DeFouw is *MUCH* better, although you must be more of an intellectual to grasp the information. Dreyers book was written for attention spanned challenged Americans, I think. It was one of the first jyotish books I bought, but I don't refer back to it when I have a question. I couldn't recommend this book.
