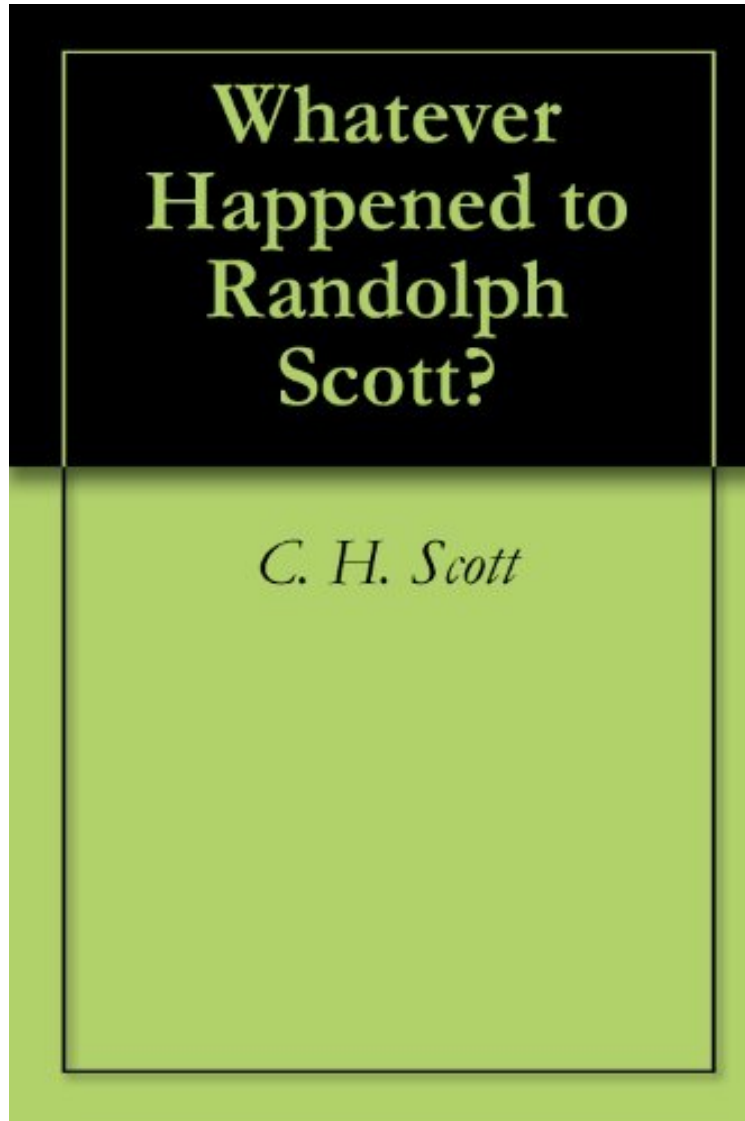

Scott after he stopped acting? why was he so different from most Hollywood stars (not giving interviews and all...)? The author does not give a definite answer to these questions, because he does not have one. While I sympathize with author's attempt to stand up for his father's reputation, I don't see how this book helped him to do that. He testifies that his father was a wonderfully dignified man, but did anyone who followed Randolph Scott's life and career ever doubt that? I don't think so...I could not help feeling sorry for C.H. Scott, as I was reading this book, because it seems to me as if he was pre-occupied with one thing only: desperately trying to refute "rumors" about his father and Cary Grant. He has every right to do that; in fact, he should do that if he feels that it hurts his father's memory. Having read other books on the subject, I can understand C.H. Scott's anger. HOWEVER, this book is not the way to fight against "the slander". If that is what C.H. Scott wanted to achieve, then he failed miserably. Instead of being calm, factual and objective in his refute, he just keeps coming back to the issue throughout the whole book. It gets very redundant...FINALLY, the author talks about his own life too much. If this book was titled: "Me and My Dad, Randolph Scott", "My Life with My Dad, Randolph Scott" or something like that, I would have given it 3 or may be even 4 stars. There're not even any good photos, except for one: young George Randolph Scott in his family house...What an elegant and proud man he was! He lived to be 90 and never lost it.
