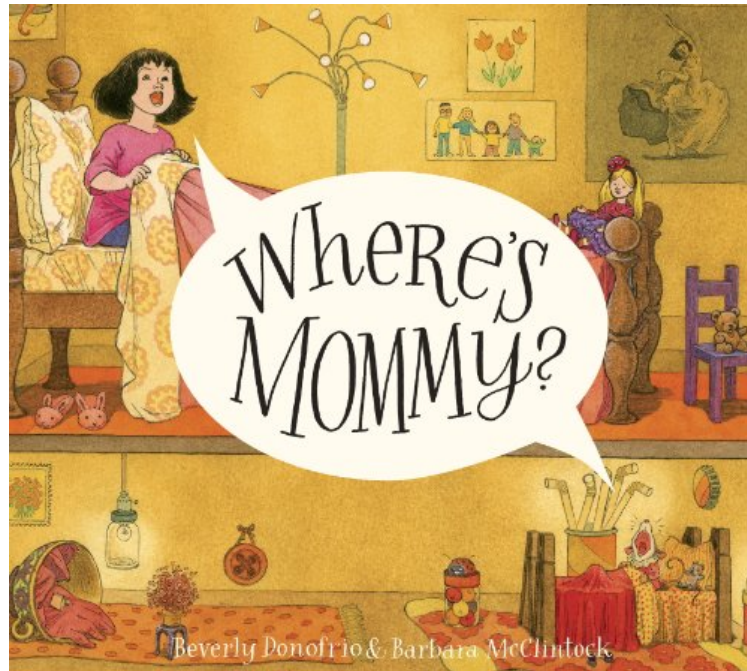

So, both girls live their parallel lives, going into bed at the same time, even calling their mothers at the same time. But surprisingly this evening both of their mothers are gone and nowhere to be found. Maria and Mouse Mouse will try to find their mothers, they will ask their family members, but they cannot find out anything. Suddenly they will notice a light in the shed and will go there together. Those familiar with the authors first book will know whom they saw there, while all others will be surprised seeing that two mothers are just as good friends as their daughters. Where's Mommy? is a parallel story and a kind of sequel of Beverly Donofrio's previously published work that speaks about friendship of two generations. The illustrations that picture many details of human and mice worlds made using upstairs/downstairs approach are nicely drawn and will appeal to children from 3 years onwards.
