And I spent almost a fortune on it. After so many books now, I came up with a few favorites - and this is one of it.Many might know the Witchblade story, but imho this is the best up to Vol 6. It is a kind of cross-over Volume to the Darkness series and a great one at

that. The storyline is fast paced and never loses momentum. Still, the characters are very vivid and deeply drawn. This comic is no child's game. It is definitely adults only, but still no explicit scenes. Just some really ugly pictures, which are all the more believable and sexy thanks to the concise love story behind it. Just make sure you don't drool on the pages. There is some gore and blood - as to be expected - some nudity and some language. Still, it makes it all the more believable and realistic, if you might say so for a fantasy tale. The art is just marvelous and taken to new heights, especially by Stjepan Sejic. The pictures really remind me of the medieval painter Hieronymus Bosch. They are so full of horror, angst and a fascinating, seemingly overbearing manifestation of a fantasy dreamworld. The art is so impeccable, it ranks among the best I have ever - I mean EVER - seen in print. Some of them almost to a degree of photorealistic clarity, you hardly ever come across. I found myself really stunned sometimes and just looking at it from one end to the other to take it all in. Then again, this must also be brought up, in the last few pages the painting style changes completely to the more simplistic, standard approach. As to why - I don't know. I liked the Darkness as well, and found this crossover to be most satisfying. You don't need necessarily the other Volumes to get the hang of it, but it will definitely help it. This is a must for any dark fantasy addict and mandatory for the Witchblade community. _____ Just a quick note about some binding issues of the Witchblade Volumes, you might have heard of. The initial print of the first 3 Volumes were severely affected by a batch of bad glue. Top Cow is most forthcoming about it. Just write them and you will see. This is a nice example how companies should treat their customers. From Vol. 4 on you will have no problems with the binding.
