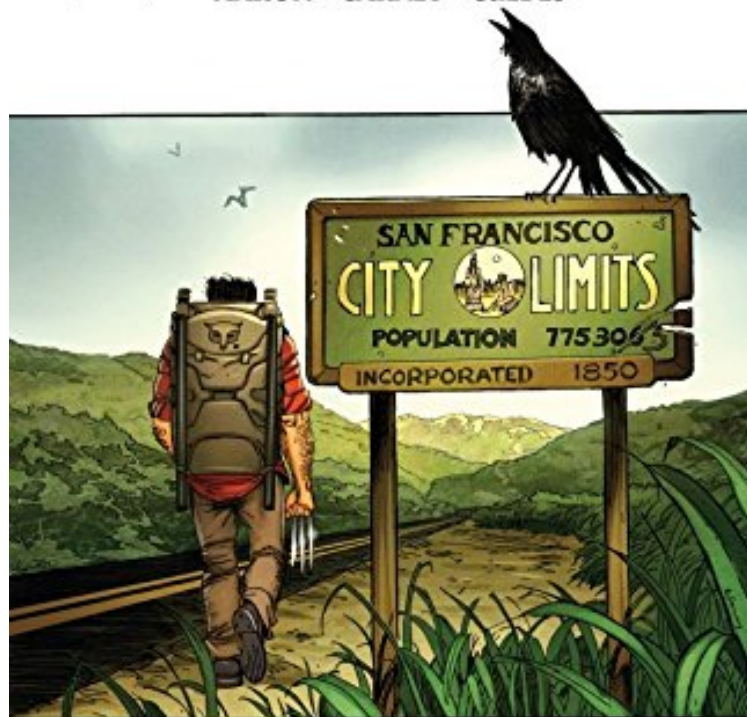

Having been a fan of Claremont/David/Hama's approach to the character in the late 80s/early 90s I have stayed away from this feature for a

long time since. Overexposure on one hand, too much hacking and slashing on the other hand did this. Now I have been drawn to the new "Wolverine the X-Men" series by the same author, and in an interview Aaron said, that his approach to the character would be similar to the one in his last two Wolverine arcs. So I gave this one a try. Well, there IS a lot of hacking and slashing (and Wolverine still is featured in about half a dozen Marvel books at least each month), but this is definitely a fun story. Guest appearances by Gorilla Man and Fat Cobra guarantee an element of parody, the art of Garney is A ok, coloring directly on pencils without inking makes them a bit rough and sketchy. What I have a problem with is that these days Marvel packs 4 puny issues into a hardcover book and wants a lot of money for this. This costs them one star in my book.
